3. ELIGIBILITY: All individuals who have paid the appropriate entry fee, individuals under the age of 18 are required to have a written consent from parent or guardian. Each entry must include at least one member of the United Brotherhood of Carpenters & Joiners. Anyone who won in excess of \$5,000.00 in 2021 and fishing guides are both ineligible.  10. BOAT IDENTIFICATION: A contestant number must be available at all times during the Tournament and post carpenter sticker.
 11. SCORING: Largemouth Bass, Kentucky Bass and Smallmouth Bass will be counted. Total stringer weight per team will determine place. Any bass under fifteen (15) inches presented for weigh-in will cause two (2) pounds to be subtracted from stringer weight. Six (6) fish per boat may be weighed in and you must cull your fish on the lake. No frozen, iced, mangled or dead fish will be weighed in. Contestants must be in sight of their partners during the Tournament hours and until they have weighed in. THE GATOR GRIP Tournament Ruler will be the official measuring device. the official measuring device.
