TRAINING

The AEC/Local 57 Joint Apprenticeship program was designed to meet industry needs by utilizing input from both contractors and electricians. The program is approved and registered with the United States Department of Labor (DOL). The electrical program requires 800 hours of classroom training along with 8,000 hours of on-the-job training.

For the classroom training, all apprentices will attend the Associated Electrical Contractors/LU 57 state-of-the-art training facility. The apprentices will receive training in every aspect of the electrical industry including:

- AC and DC Theory
- National Electric Code
- Commercial/ Industrial Power
- Motor Logic/ Motor Controls
- Solar and Photovoltaic Systems
- VFD's and PLC's

Every Local 57 Electrician MUST BE DRUG FREE. We use a Department of Transportation approved Drug Testing Policy. Each electrician must PASS a drug test and be subject to random drug screenings.

YOUR FIRST STEPS

- Complete a program application online.
- Obtain a letter of intent from one of our signatory electrical contractors.
- Complete the indenture process.

AS AN APPRENTICE

- You will attend four weeks of scheduled school sessions per year.
- You will get paid on the job training and earn an increasing rate of pay as you progress through the program.
- You will earn full health insurance coverage, dental, and retirement pension.

THROUGHOUT - YOUR CAREER

As a graduate of the apprenticeship program, you will receive advanced skill-level training and safety courses which include:

- National Electrical Code
- Fundamentals of Low Voltage
- Arc Flash Awareness
- Construction Management/Supervision
- Solar and Photovoltaic Systems
- OSHA 30
