WHAT IS A FLOORLAYER?

HOW DO I QUALIFY?

To begin the Floorlayer apprenticeship program, you must be:

- At least 17 years old
- Have a High school diploma or equivalent or earn your equivalent within one year of beginning apprenticeship program.
- Pass a drug test
- Be able to perform the physical demands necessary of the floor laying industry

If you want to get a head start, enroll in a shop class and study math in school. Understanding these skills can help you become a successful candidate.
