## WHAT TO EXPECT

- Your time will be divided between working for your contractor, attending classes, and hands-on instruction at the St. Louis Carpenters Training Center, four days at a time, four times annually.
- The Carpenters Joint Apprenticeship Program (CJAP) has eight terms that take approximately four years to complete.
- You'll earn while you learn (while earning medical and pension benefits!) and move up the pay scale each term on your way to becoming a journey-level carpenter.
- After working 6,000 on-the-job learning hours and completing 18 units of training, you'll graduate from CJAP as a journey-level carpenter.

## MORE ABOUT CJAP AND BEYOND

Upon reaching a journey-level status, credits toward an Associate of Applied Science degree are awarded at many of the region's community colleges. A college degree can enhance your technical skills and make you a more attractive job candidate to employers.

Various no cost associates degrees options are available through the Carpenters Joint Apprenticeship Program to active apprentices.
