The Union of which your parent is a member must be an affiliate of The Mid-America Carpenters Regional Council. Additionally, your parent must be a member of Local 237, 243, 270, 662, 664, 1693.

Please make certain:

- 1.) The application is completed in full and it is signed by you.
- 2.) A 250 word essay is submitted with the application
- 3.) All required supporting documentation is submitted with the application

1. Any active member or any Son, Daughter, or Stepchildren of any active member of this Southern Region who is a member in good standing and whose dues are current throughout the Scholarship Drawing will be eligible for this random drawing scholarship.
2. Application process and requirements:
 - a. Submit 250 words essay entitled: What has it meant to be from a Union Family-United Brotherhood of Carpenters.
 - b. Must have a high school diploma or General Education Development (GED) and be under the age of twenty-five (25).
 - c. Must be enrolled full time-12 hours or more per semester-in a Community College, State/Private Universities or graduating from certified High School and provide copy of College or High School transcript.
 - d. Must maintain a C grade point average and copy of grades submitted for previous semester.
 - e. Copy of tuition payments made to the Institution must be submitted prior to receiving scholarship at completion of each new school year.
3. Application filing:
 - a. All applications must be received (or postmarked) by **October 1st** of each year hereafter to be eligible.
